### A Multi Media Presentation Competition on the Anzac Tradition with emphasis on WW1

These are the rules and terms and conditions for entering The Beechworth Theatre Company's Multimedia Presentation Competition. Please ensure that you read and understand them as failure will result in your entry not being considered.

#### **Definition:**

**Multimedia:** an audio, video, animation, interactive features, and still images in various ways and combinations made possible through the advancement of technology. By combining media and content, those interested in multimedia can take on and work with a variety of media forms to get their content across. Multimedia can be accessed through computers or electronic devices and integrates the various forms together. One example of multimedia would be combining a website with video, audio, or text images.

#### RULES

- 1. Entry is only open to anyone who is over the age of 18 as at 1 July, 2015. You must be a resident in the shire of Indigo.
- 2. Entrants must not be involved with The Beechworth Theatre Company Inc. their close relatives or any person connected with the competition.
- 3. Entrants should construct a multimedia presentation on the subject, "The Anzac Traditions with emphasis on World War 1." The presentation should contain a combination of either a narrative of up to 3000 words, pictorial historic elements and motion pictures, slideshow or power point of no more than 20 minutes duration.
- 4. The narratives must not have been professionally produced in any medium. Any pictures or motion picture content must comply with standard copyright legislation.
- 5. Multimedia presentations entered in the competition must not, at the time they are submitted, have been offered for publication in any other form or medium to any other person or competition. (including but not limited to being uploaded to a public file sharing site, posted in online forums, message boards or social media sites). Nor can they, at the time of entry or during the course of the competition, have been entered for any other competition. The winning entry will be deemed to have entered into an undertaking not to accept offers for their entries from companies or publishers before December 2015.
- 6. All narratives included in the multimedia presentations submitted must be up to a maximum of 3,000 words and not more 20 minutes duration of motion picture, song or Power Point /slideshow content. The presentation must be written in English or if a foreign language is used, it must be accompanied by English subtitles. Presentations are to be submitted on DVD or memory stick and compatible with Windows and Apple operating systems.

- 7. The competition opens on 17 April, 2015 and closes on 31 August, 2015.
- 8. The entry fee for the competition is \$10 Australian per entry, payable by cheque, money order or via electronic transfer. Details for this are: A/C name; The Beechworth Theatre Company Inc; BSB: 033 207, A/C No. 114698,
- 9. Entries must be received by The Beechworth Theatre Company by 31 August, 2015. Entries received after this time will not be considered.
- 10. Entries must be submitted either:

- 12. All entries must be the original work of a student of the school and must not infringe the rights of any other party. The Beechworth Theatre Company Inc. accepts no liability if entrants ignore these rules and entrants agree to fully indemnify The Beechworth Theatre Company Inc. against any claims by any third party arising from any breach of these rules.
- 13. Entries must not contain defamatory, obscene or any other unsuitable material, such as that which may cause offence to a wide audience of all ages.
- 14. The winner and runner-up retain the copyright in their entries but grant to The Beechworth Theatre Company Inc. a non-exclusive licence to broadcast their entry across all media, as well as use of it on any online platforms.
- 15. The prize for the winning entry will be to the value of \$500 with an individual prize to the winning author, and a runner's up prize provided by the Beechworth RSL of \$100. The prizes are as stated and cannot be deferred or transferred.
- 16. The applicant's name must not appear on the presentation.
- 17. No corrections will be accepted or correspondence entered into.
- 18. Results will be announced at 10:00 am on Saturday, 21 November, 2015 at the Beechworth Servicemen's Memorial Hall, Ford Street, Beechworth.
- 19. The judges' decision is final.
