These are the rules and terms and conditions for entering The Beechworth Theatre Company's Anzac Essay Writing Competition. Please ensure that you read and understand them as failure to follow will result in your entry not being considered.

RULES

- 1. Entry is open to Primary Schools in the shire of Indigo.
- 2. Three entries from each school are permitted.
- 3. Entrants must not be involved with The Beechworth Theatre Company, their close relatives or any person connected to the competition.
- 4. Entrants should write an essay of up to 3,000 words length on the subject "*The Future and Importance of Anzac Day*". It can be historical or set in the present day.
- 5. Essays entered must not have been professionally produced in any medium.
- 6. Essays entered in the competition must not, at the time they are submitted, have been offered for publication in any other form or medium to any other person or competition. Nor can they, at the time of entry or during the course of the competition, have been entered for any other competition. The winning school will be deemed to have entered into an undertaking not to accept offers for their entries from companies or publishers before December 2015.
- 7. All essays submitted must be up to a maximum of 3,000 words. The essay must be written in English and in a typed format, double spaced, using standard 12 point font on singled sided numbered pages and not stapled. If submitting by post, three copies are required.
- 8. The competition opens on 17 April, 2015 and closes on 31 August, 2015.
- 9. Entries must be received by The Beechworth Theatre Company by 31 August, 2015. Entries received after this time will not be considered.
- 10. Entries must be submitted either:

- 11. All entries must be accompanied by a completed copy of the entry form which can be downloaded at <u>beechworththeatrecom.wix.com/beechworththeatreco</u> from 13 April 2015.

- 12. All entries must be the original work of a student of the school and must not infringe the rights of any other party. The Beechworth Theatre Company accepts no liability if entrants ignore these rules and entrants agree to fully indemnify The Beechworth Theatre Company against any claims by any third party arising from any breach of these rules.
- 13. Entries must not contain defamatory, obscene or any other unsuitable material, such as that which may cause offence to a wide audience of all ages.
- 14. The winner and runner-up retain the copyright in their entries but grant to The Beechworth Theatre Company a non-exclusive licence to broadcast their entry across all media, as well as use of it on any online platforms.
- 15. The prize for the winning entry will be to the value of \$450 with an individual prize to the winning author, and a runner's up prize provided by the Beechworth RSL of \$100. The prizes are as stated and cannot be deferred or transferred.
- 16. The applicant's name must not appear on the story.
- 17. No corrections will be accepted or correspondence entered into.
- 18. Results will be announced at 10:00 am on Saturday, 21 November, 2015 at the Beechworth Servicemen's Memorial Hall, Ford Street, Beechworth.
- 19. The judges' decision is final.
